Norma Lacey, told us the history of Manly Bowls Club, where her father was President from 1954 - 1957.

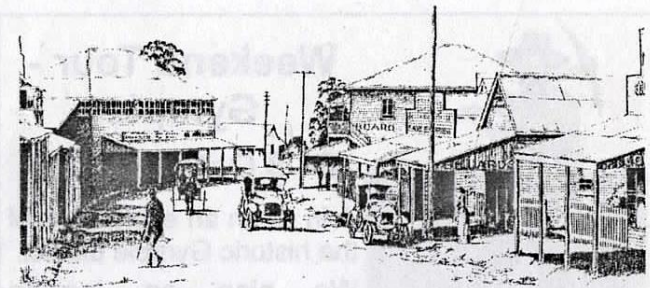
The **Lucky Door Prize** was won by Laurima Rabe, the **Raffle** by Jill Greenhill and the **Membership Draw** by Heather Smith.

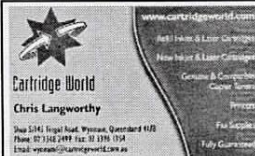
Resource Centre Report

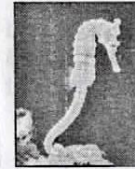

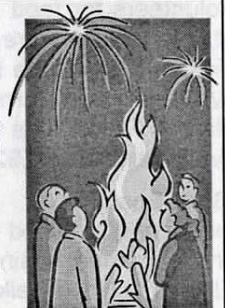
