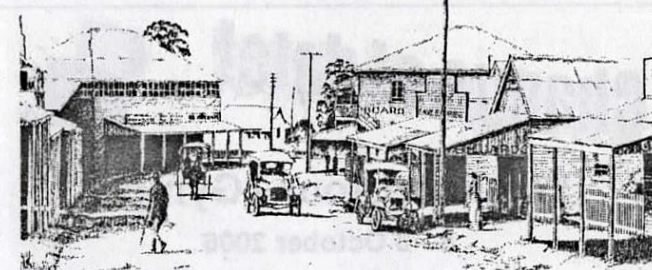
The **Lucky Door Prize** was won by Peter Hughes, the **Raffle** by John McIntyre and the **Membership Draw** by Ken Fenton.

Weekend Tour - Gympie

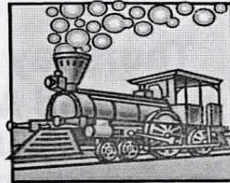
6 - 8 October 2006

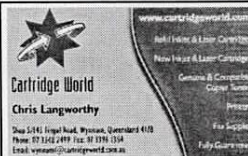

Watch them play and see the tiny baby seahorses.

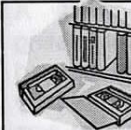
