Main Speaker. Brian Brandenburg gave us an illustrated talk of his experiences when called up as a National Serviceman, and of the time he served in Vietnam.

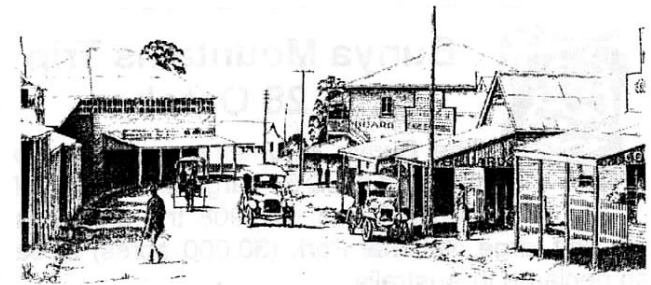
The **Raffle** was won by Anne Wenzel and the **Membership Draw** by Peter Hughes.

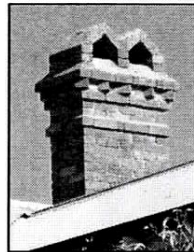


Resource Centre Report August 2007

Where was I? August 2007

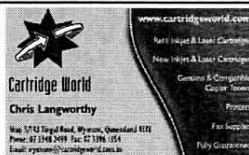


I was outside Dr Hishon's house on the corner of Bride Street and Bay Terrace. The house, 52 Bay Terrace, is called "Atherfield".

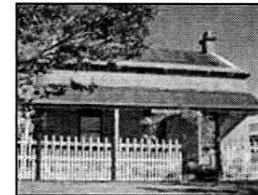
